**IN THE MATTER OF INDUSTRIAL PARK ROAD**

Lou Britton and Jim Coffenberry discussed the Industrial Road issues with the Council and proposed the Council lend the money to repair the road. The IVC TIF was originally established to help maintain the road and recently the laws changed and the TIF monies cannot be used for any type of maintenance. If the County Council would agree to loan the money the TIF would be able to pay back up to \$40,000.00 by February 2, 2017. Larry suggested we could loan the money from Rainy Day. Lou will prepare the paperwork for the October 5<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**IN THE MATTER OF CLAY COUNTY COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS GRANT**

Mary Brown explained the State is offering new monies to Community Correction Departments. This is a competitive grant and the funds will be available November 1, 2015 thru June 30, 2016. Clay County is requesting \$71,573.00. If approved the money will be on the normal grant cycle of July 1<sup>st</sup> thru June 30<sup>th</sup>.

Motion to approve the Clay County Community Corrections grant was made by Toni Carter and seconded by Jason Britton. Motion carried 7 ayes.
