


Surveyed by John Sharp Surveyor of Blay County March 5th 6th 1857 and corners set from No 16. Run at 5 1/4"

- No 5 Sand Stone. Original Sec. corner.
- No 6 Middle S.W. quarter. Sassafras Stake, S Gum 15 E S 30 Links
- No 7 N.W. quarter set from the S. side sand stone, marked 1/4 Sec. Elm 18 W 1/2 Links
- No 8 Middle N.W. quar. S Gum Stake, Beech 20 S 41 E 16 L.
" " Grey Ash 18 W N 21 E 17 Links
- No 9 N side N.W. sand stone. B. Oak 6 E. W 8 1/2 N 11 links
" " R. Oak 16 S S 18 W 7 links
- No 10 1/4 mile on N side dogwood stake, Ash 8 S E 10 S 14 Links
" " Dog wood 6 E N 20 W 10 1/2 Links
- No 11 Center corner on E side of N.W. quar. Poplar Stake
" " W. Oak 4 S N 6 E 5 2 link
- No 12 Middle sec. Stake Red Oak 28 S N 46 W 32 links
- No 13 W side of S E quar. Sassafras Stake, S. Ash 15 S. W 5 S 17 links
- No 15 Middle S. E. quar. on S side Sassafras stake, Beech 20 W S 8 1/2 W 31 1/2 Links
- No 16 Middle S. E. quar. "Dog wood Stake" Poplar 30 S S 40 E 4 links
- No 17 Middle S. E. quar on N side dogwood stake Hickory 20 S N 19 W 24 Links
- No 20 Stake Original corner.
- No 21 Middle N E quar on E side "dog wood Stake" Beech 20 S S 41 W 17 links
" " W. Oak 22 S N 35 W 25 Links
- No 23 Middle S. E. quar on E side Sassafras stake, Beech 20 S, S 8 1/2 W 31 L,
- No 24 Stake Original Sec. corner
