And the following line run, according to the descriptions of the deeds of M. P. Fritz and Mrs. Elizabeth Cummins. No changes were made in location of lines or corners.
A shortage of 18.25^{ft} was found in line east and west, and said shortage was equally divided to M. P. Fritz on the west and Mrs. E. Cummins on the east.
