

Second Meridian.

- Corner No. 4. A S.R.R. D. set S $86^{\circ}43'W$ 4 chains and 8 links distant - (No witnesses)
- Corner No. 5. A S.R.R. D. 2 ft. 4 inches long. Set S. $84^{\circ}40'W$ 23 rods 19 $\frac{1}{4}$ Links distant - From which a S.R.R. D. 2 feet 4 inches long - From which a S.R.R. D. 2 ft. long S. $5^{\circ}15'E$. 46 Links and a S.R.R. D. 23 inches long N $88^{\circ}4'W$ 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ Links - Thence S $3^{\circ}16'E$. 6 chains and 81 Links to the place of Beginning
- Corner 1. Small R.R. D. - set 35 rods, 10 feet, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ inches West of a of a corner on the East Sec. line, which is 20 rods and 3 links North of the $\frac{1}{2}$ mile corner on said line
From which, a S.R.R. Iron 1 ft 7 in. long S. $17^{\circ}E$. 332 and a S.R.R. Iron 19 in. long N $83^{\circ}2'W$ 32 L.
- Corner No. 6 Small R.R. Iron 22 inches long. set 35 rods 10 ft 5 inches West of the East Sec. line, on a line running N from the South East corner of the N.E. q. of the S.E. q. of Sec. 16 at an angle so as to strike the West line, said N.E. q. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods north of the S.W. corner of said N.E. of the S.E. From which a S.R.R. D. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. long N. $9^{\circ}E$. 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ Links and a Do. Do. 15 " " N. $86^{\circ}2'W$ 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- Corner No. 8. Small R.R. D. 21 in. long. Set in line between A and B (see old Record) (p. 206) - From a S.R.R. D. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. long. N. with line 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ links. and a line stone South 15 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 20 Links
Corners 6, 7 and 8 were set June the 20th 1883, Philip Boor and Charles Somers, chainmen, William Somers flagman all sworn as the law requires, Joseph Somers and Joseph Wardlaw parties interested, present, and consent.

- Corners 9 and 10 Set by T.B. Robertson Surveyor of C. C. May 18th 1893 by request of Thomas Lint and consent of J. N. Wardlaw's heirs. parties interested
- Cor 9 A sand stone marked W. L. lying flat with a nigger head on top said corner is S. $2^{\circ}4'W$. from corner 1, 16 chains and 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ links and at the west side of the Highland Coal company's south and about 24 rods and 10 links north of a branch or creek.
- Cor. 10 An Iron or Stone marked T on West line of E. $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section and 10, ch's 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ Links South from the center of said Section, and 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ Lhs South from corner X. (See page 578 in Record 1)
