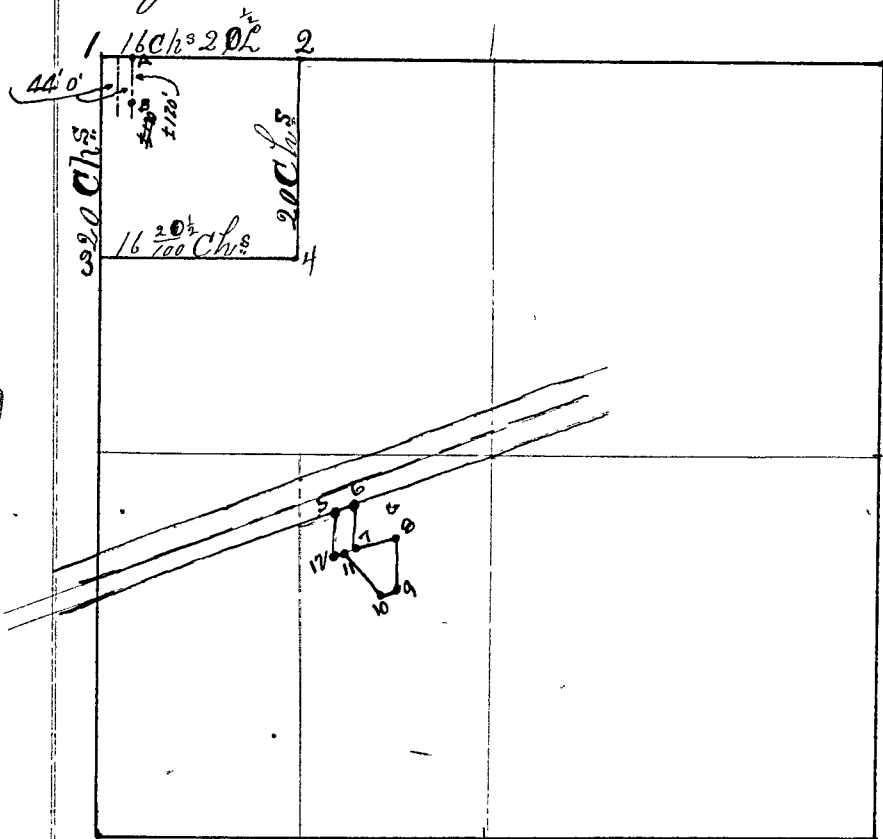

A Bur oak 16 in. N. 85 1/2 W. 56 1/2 Links and
A Stone North 86 East 30 Links
Corner, N^o 2 A small "T" Iron 21 in. long - 16 Ch. 20 Links East of Cor. N^o 1.
From which an Elm 16 in. dia. S. 79 E. 21 1/2 Links and
An Elm 24 in. dia. S. 70 1/2 W. 142 1/2 Links distant.
Corner, N^o 3. An Iron Bar 1 in square, 24 1/2 in. long - 20 Ch. S. of Cor. N^o 1
From which an Elm 3 in. dia. S. 12 1/2 W. 18 1/2 Links.
Corner, N^o 4. An Iron Bar nearly Round with 12. gr. inch holes through
it. Bar 19 in. long. 2nd Set 20 Ch. East from Cor. N^o 3.
From which a Sweet Gum 14 in. dia. S. 40 E. 46 Links and
An Elm 24 N. 29 1/2 E. 64 Links distant
