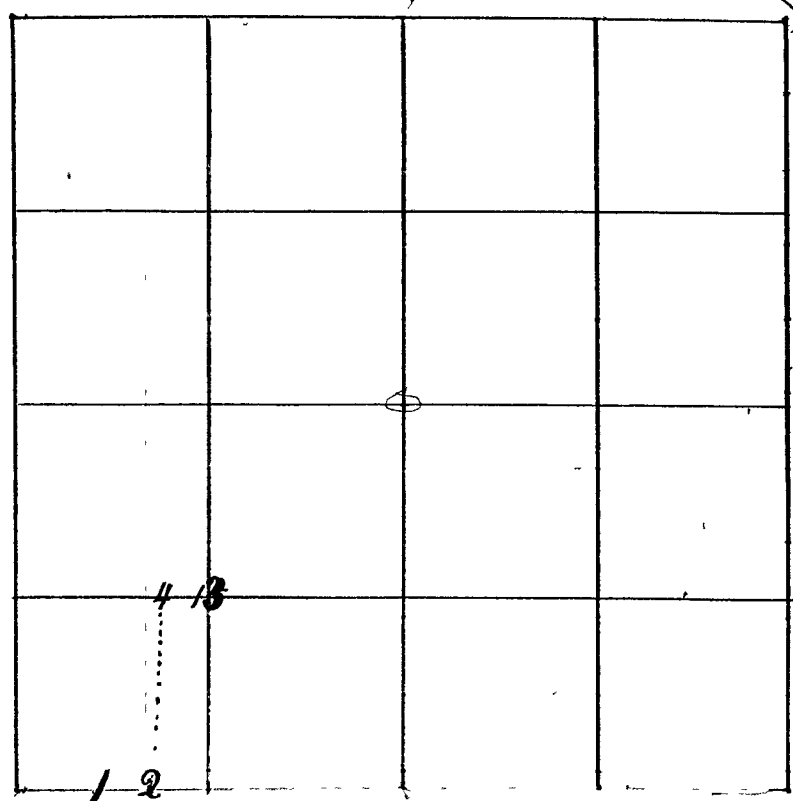


Surveyed by Thomas B Robertson Surveyor of

Corner No 4 Sand Stone 4.98 $\frac{1}{2}$ chs West of the center of the S. 24. g.
