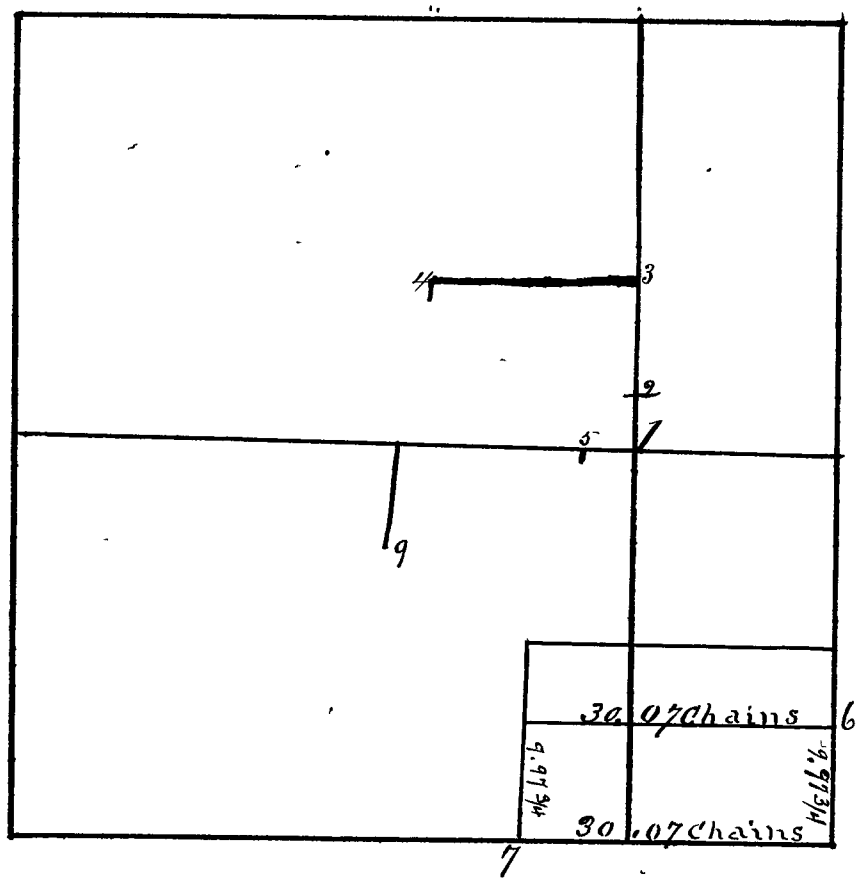

- Corner N^o 1. Sand Stone (Mr. $\frac{1}{8}$) at center of East-half
 Witnessed by corner N^o 2.
- " 2. a Sand Stone (Mr. H.) Set 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains North of Corner N^o 1
 Witnessed by a White Oak 15 in. in dia. N. 2° 45' E. 3.27 chains
- " 3. A Sand Stone (Mr. L. 28-10) Set 28 rods and 10 feet North from
 Corner N^o 2. No witness taken.
- " 4. A Sand Stone Mr. L. T. J. 43 rods and 10 feet West
 from corner number 3 - No witness taken.
- " 5. A Sand Stone (Mr. B. 13) Set 13 and $\frac{1}{2}$ rods West of corner 1
 and a little North of West is a Black Walnut (double) 28 in.
 in diameter 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ links, exact bearing was not taken
 * also to corner N^o 2 a Black Walnut (double) 28 inches in dia S 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ W.
 3.84 chains.
- " 6. A Sand Stone (Mr. T) 24 rods and 21 links W. of Cor. N^o 1 also
 another 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ links West of corner N^o 6 being the N.W. corner of a
 strip Elizabeth Wrigg bought from Elizabeth Weaver on June
 29th 1885 = deed made by Thomas B. Robertson Surveyor C.C.
