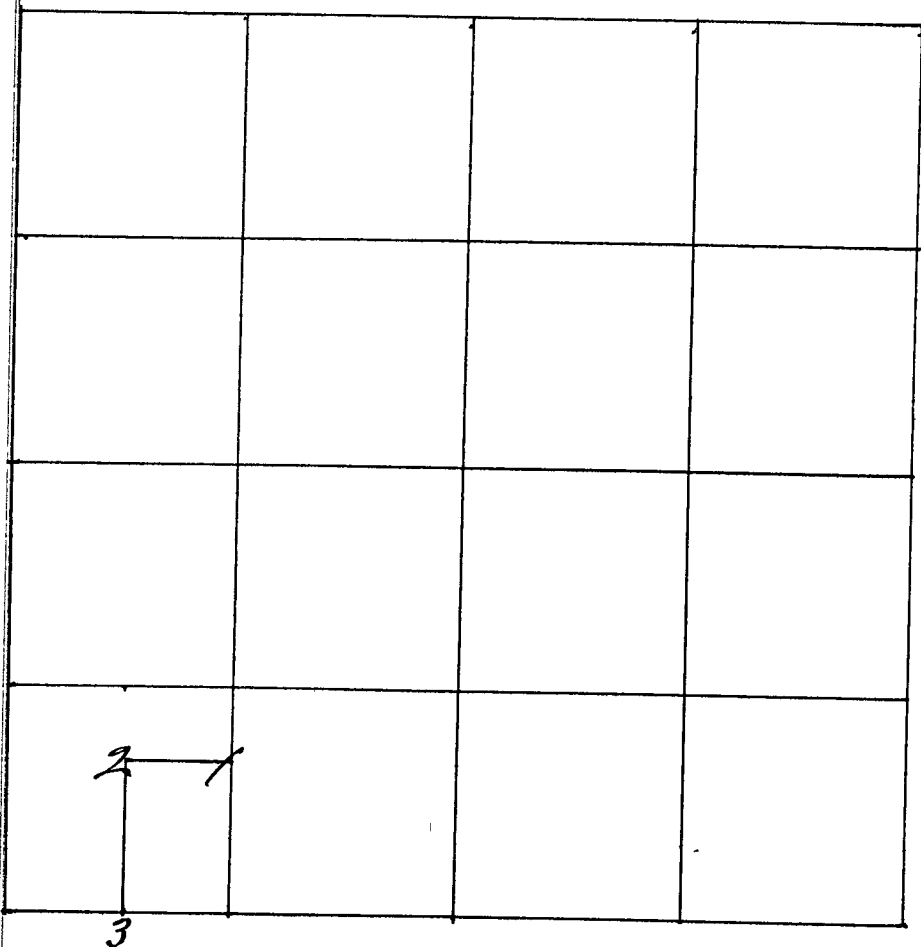

" " East corner of the South west quarter of the South west quarter
" " from which a Sycamore 12 in is N $23\frac{1}{4}$ E 10 lks
" " And a Stone 14 in is West 25 lks
" " 2 Sand Stone 16 in long set 40 rods west of No 1
" " Sand Stone 10 in East 20 lks
" " Sand Stone 8 South 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ lks
" " 3 Tigger Head 12 in set 40 rods west of the South East
" " Corner of the South west quarter of the South west quarter
" " from which a Cedar 6 in is S $20\frac{3}{4}$ W 36 lks
" " And a Tigger Head 10 in is North 70 lks
