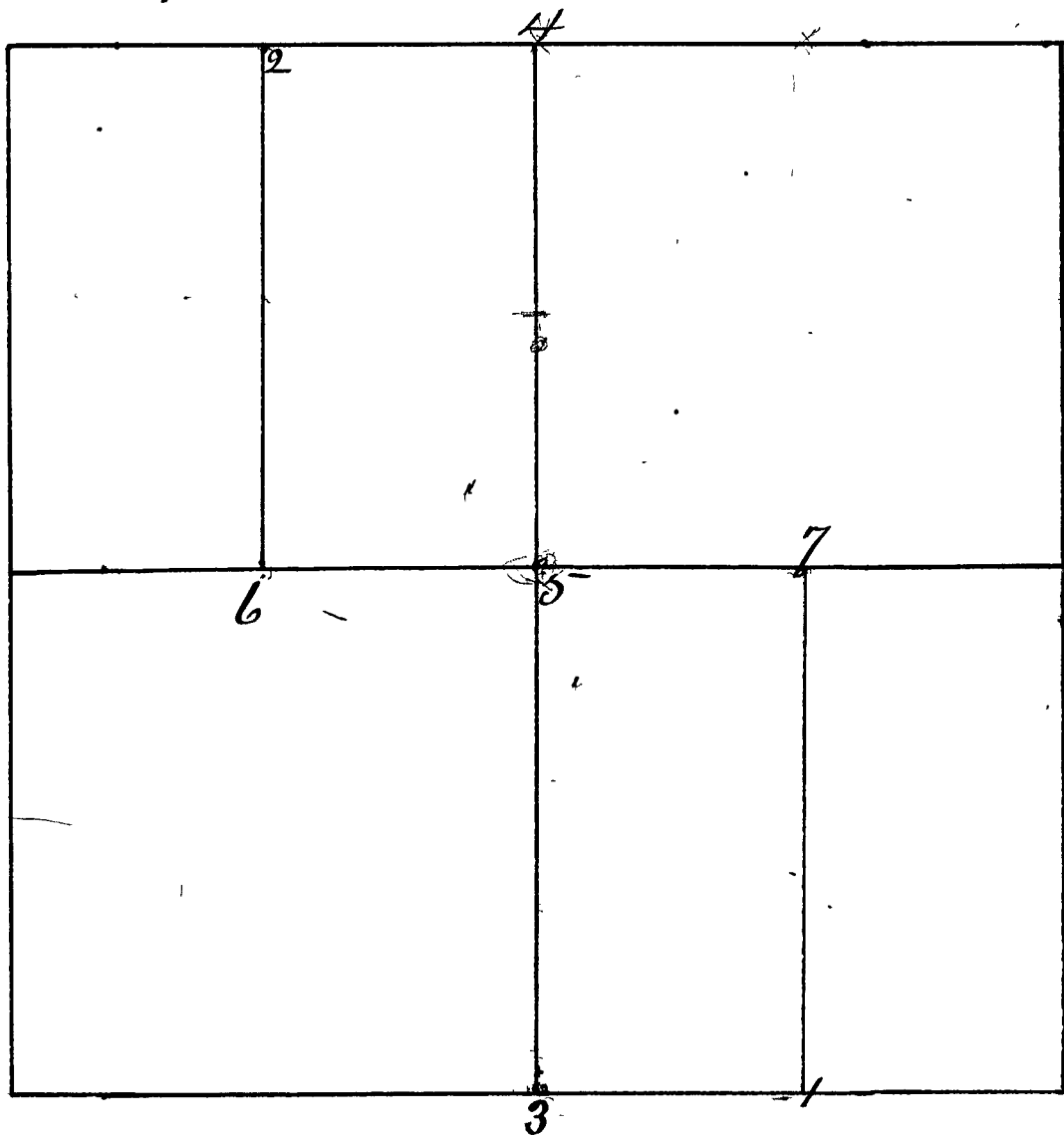

- corner 1. A Sand Stone marked $\frac{1}{16}$ from which a J. Oak 12 in. N $51\frac{1}{2}$ W. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ L.
 and a Maple 12 S $34\frac{1}{2}$ W. 55 Links.
- corner 2. A Bastard Lime Stone Mr. $\frac{1}{16}$
- corner 3. A Pump joint 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ Ft. deep and a Bastard Lime Stone Mr. $\frac{1}{4}$ on
 the top of the joint, with small joint beside the stone
- corner 4. A Round Iron 2 feet long and $\frac{7}{8}$ in. in dia. ^{Maple 22 in North 45° W. 86 $\frac{1}{2}$ L.}
- " 5. A Gas pipe with a $\frac{7}{8}$ in. Iron rod inside - 2 feet long
 from which a Jack oak 12 in. N $40\frac{1}{2}$ W. 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ L.
 and a Maple 10 S $31\frac{1}{2}$ E. 120 $\frac{3}{4}$ Links
- " 6. A Sand Stone Mr. $\frac{1}{8}$
- " 7. A Gas pipe 19 in. long fat at lower end, driven at the center of
 the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section
