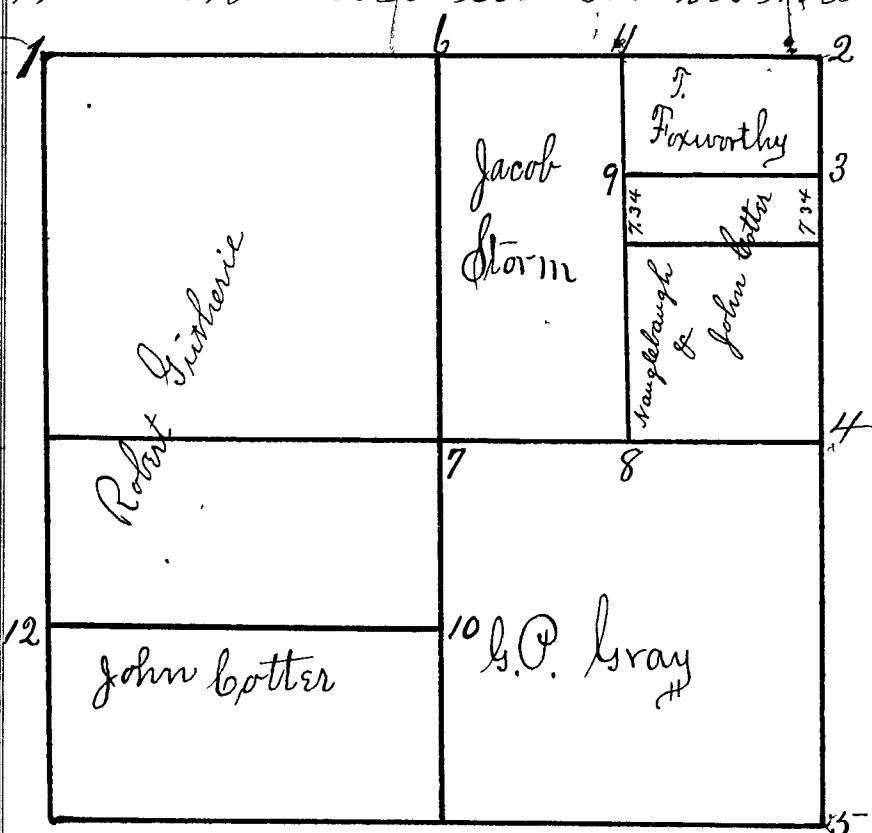

Thomas Foxworthy 2^d Adam Nanglebaugh were chairmen, Robert Gutherie, flagman on the 16th 2^d John Cotter flagman on the 17th 2^d 18th all sworn as the law requires, and corners set from 1 to 12.

- " 6. A Sand Stone marked 1/4 Witnessed by a Sand Stone marked N. S. 28 1/5 E. 62 Lks.
- " 7. A Sand Stone marked 1/4 S Witnessed by a Sand Stone m. T East 23 Lks.
- " 8. A Sand Stone (20 in.) marked 1/6 Witnessed by a Sand Stone marked W North 16 3/4 Lks.
- " 9. A Sand Stone marked 1/8 (Set 7.34 chains north from the South West corner of the N. E. N. E. Witnessed by a Sand Stone North 23 1/2 Lks.
- " 10. A Sand Stone marked 1/8 Witnessed by a Sand Stone marked W. West 23 3/5 Lks.
