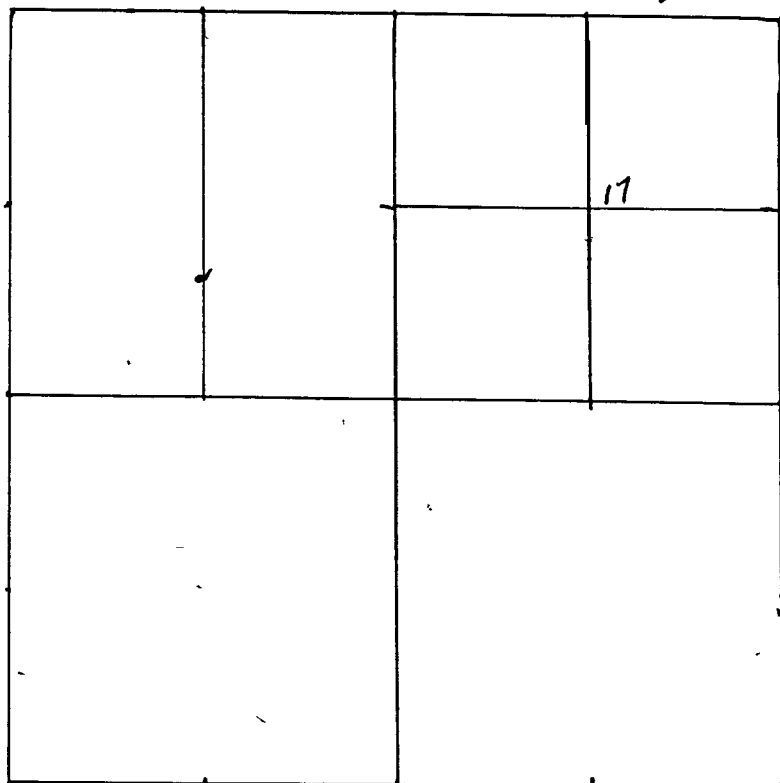


Further surveyed by L.W. Kinn, July 29, 30 + 31st 1902. after the following notice being served,

Said property line on East end to be 63 feet south of cor #17 which was placed there in the year 1872 by Wm. B. Crist, and found by me to be placed too far North.

I, John Morgan and Samuel E. Parsons agree in the presence of Oscar J. Jenkins, County Surveyor of Clay County, to make present fence line between the N. E. corner of South East quarter of North west quarter and the North east corner of the South west quarter of the North east quarter, the property line between lands owned by the above mentioned parties
