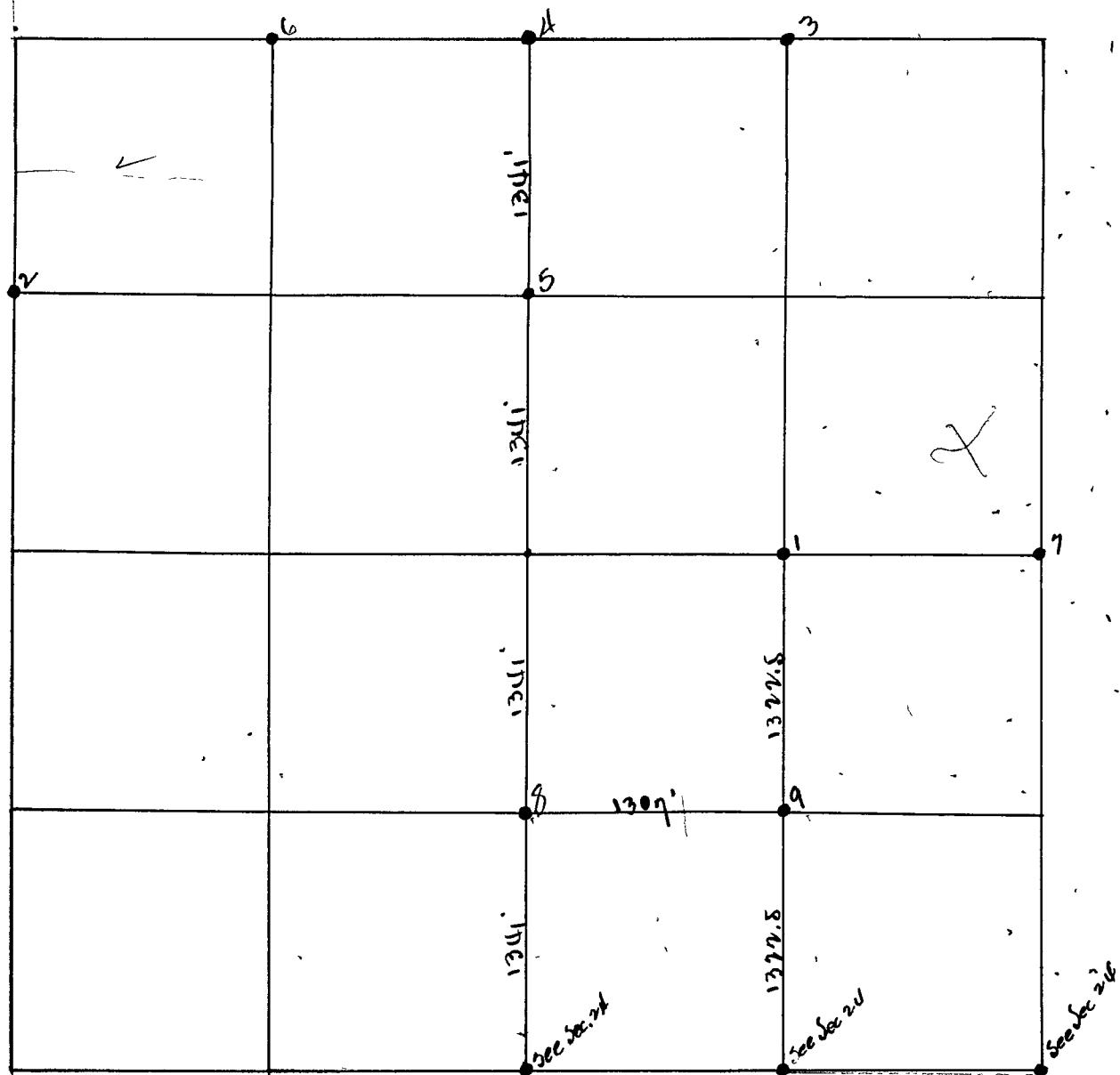

Corner #1. Sandstone 24" marked $\frac{1}{16}$. Witness Beech 70" S 77 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ hts. Beech 12" N 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ hts.

Corner #2. Flint stone 19". Witness Sandstone 17" 20° W - 32 hts. Niggerhead 19" South 31 hts.

Corner #3. Sandstone 14" marked $\frac{1}{16}$ brick put under it. Gum 18" S 18 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E - 18 hts. Sandstone 14" N 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 18 hts.

Corner #4. Sandstone Marked $\frac{1}{4}$. 18" long. Crockery and brick under it. Beech 18" S 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 63 hts. S.S. 12" S 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W - 41 hts.

Corner #5. Sandstone 15" Marked $\frac{1}{16}$. Crockery under it. Sandstone 12" S 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W 52. Sandstone 10" N 50 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E - 35 hts.

Corner #6. Sandstone 15. " " Sassafras 10" N 10° E - 12. B. Walnut 5" S 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E - 40 hts.

Corner #7. Sandstone 15". White Oak 24". S 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W - 46 hts.

Corner #8. Sandstone 10" x 6" x 4". Sandstone 15" x 8" x 2" Pointed top West 15 feet.
